Using Heat to Kill Bed Bugs

The process is also time consuming (taking 6-8 hours from setup to take down), and therefore expensive (\$1,200 or more depending on the size of the area to be treated and the time to reach temperature) Heat treatment is one of the few methods that can be used alone for bed bug con-trol

Protect Our Turtles

Habitat degradation can take many forms Riprap or walls built along shores can be a death trap for hatchling turtles on their way to water Turtles need sunny, open areas to lay their eggs Planting sod or trees along shorelines can force females to travel further to lay their eggs or next in unsuitable sites such as along roads or in crop ields
